Payment Process - Israeli Partners

General

◆ TL;DR

- ◆ Payment Terms: Net 60
 - ◆ Minimum Payment: \$200
 - ◆ Currency: USD
 - ◆ Payment Method: Payoneer
- ◆ Payments are processed on a Net 60 basis (e.g., revenue from January is paid in April).
- ◆ Minimum payment amount is \$200 net (based on your revenue share). If your earnings are below \$200, they'll roll over to the next payment period until the threshold is reached.
- ◆ Payments are processed via Payoneer, and can only be transferred in USD.

Reporting

- ◆ On your partner's dashboard, you can find daily data of your app performance and revenue.
- ◆ The revenue numbers in the dashboard are **not final** – the actual payment amount will be sent by email after reconciling all campaigns.
- ◆ Video ad revenue is updated daily, while display ad revenue is updated monthly.

- ◆ (Only relevant to businesses registered in Israel.)
- ◆ Israeli tax law requires you to issue an invoice.
- ◆ Please send your invoice (חשבונית עסקה) to finance@overwolf.com.
- ◆ The invoice should be based on the monthly revenue email, sent to you at the end of each month.
- ◆ The invoice should include the following:
 - ◆ Company name
 - ◆ Company address
 - ◆ Amount for payment
 - ◆ Amount including local tax
- ◆ Once payment is received, please send your tax invoice (חשבונית מס) to finance@overwolf.com.



Israeli Partners

- ◆ Please provide us with the following:
 - ◆ Valid book management certificate (אישור ניהול ספרים בתוקף).
 - ◆ Valid tax deduction certificate (אישור לניכוי מס במקור בתוקף).
 - ◆ Please issue the invoice in USD.
